- All other financial matters, including travel costs, are subject to negotiation, and will normally be the responsibility of the persons involved and decision of their home college.
- The host college will agree to provide work space, access library and avail technical facilities accordingly.

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The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective as on 03/03/2023 (Effective date) to establish an affiliation by and between Domkal Girls' College, a West Bengal Government Aided undergraduate Degree College with its office at Domkal, P.O-Domkal, District - Murshidabad, West Bengal (India), Pin-742303, established in 2011, hereafter referred to as PC and represented by its Principal, referred to as FIRST PARTY, for the purpose of exchange of students, staffs and faculties.

AND

Dumkal College, Basantapur, a West Bengal Government Aided undergraduate degree College with its office at Basantapur, Murshidabad, West Bengal (India), Pin-742406, established in 1999 affiliated to University of Kalyani, hereafter referred to as Dumkal College and represented by its Principal, referred to as SECOND PARTY,

The aforesaid institutions are hereafter referred to individually/ collectively as college/colleges

PREAMBLE

Whereas, Domkal Girls' College and Dumkal College have many areas of common interest in Arts, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit of academic excellence on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, pedagogy and research.

Now therefore, Domkal Girls' College and Dumkal College have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

Both colleges agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on the basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

A. Faculty/Staff exchanges

- Each institutions will promote the exchange of faculty for the common UG Honours & Programmes Courses.
- ii) Faculty exchange for the mutual benefit of both the institutions
- iii) Collaboration in teaching, research and development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest.
- iv) Exchange of academic materials and publications.
- v) Conducting lectures with the opportunity to teach or conduct research.
- vi) Undertaking joint research wherever feasible
- Vii) Participating in seminars, workshops, symposia, other kinds of academic discussions.
- viii) Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work wherever feasible.

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity and detailed arrangements for such collaborative work will be agreed upon

B. Student Exchange

- a) Students in the exchange programme will be nominated by mutual agreement between the home and the host college.
- b) Exchange students may be evaluated by the host institution if such an evaluative framework for the academic interest of students be worked out, this will in no way impede or influence her/his evaluation in home college or university assessment/ evaluation.
- c) Students of Domkal Girls' College will be participated in NCC Programme conducted by the NCC Unit of Dumkal College.

C. Other areas

- a) To exchange information and experiences on research and educational programmes.
- b) To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes.
- c) To jointly organize seminars, faculty development programmes, workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- d) To explore the provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff, faculty and students of both institutes.
- e) To use library reading room facilities for a specified period.
- f) To use Computer laboratory and I.C.T. facilities in specific cases (with prior approval of Head of the Institutional) for a limited period.
- g) Exchange of N.T.S. for mutual understanding of college administration, exchange of experience and skill (viz. office management, student database management, financial management & other I.T. uses etc.)

Domkal Girls' College and Dumkal College agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two colleges. These terms will include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements and person(s) responsible for its implementation

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each college shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate & fast track the programme on behalf of the Head of the Institution of each college further, a Coordination Committee consisting of two Head of the Institution and the two Coordinators will periodically (once year) review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between two colleges

ARTICLE 3 CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

The two colleges will retain and respect individual confidentiality, including those pertaining to the collaborative activities of both colleges.

ARTICLE 4: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Ownership of any intellectual property (including confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software and any other industrial or intellectual property nights) developed jointly during the course of this MoU shall be vested in both the colleges in this MoU. Both the colleges shall have right to determine the commercial implications, disposition and exploitation of such intellectual property and shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall be possible with prior written consent of both colleges

ARTICLES 5: VALIDITY

Initially, the MoU shall remain in force for a period of five (05) years commencing from the effective date Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review

ARTICLE 6: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of One (01) month in advance to

ARTICLE 7: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the two colleges. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

ARTICLE 8: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case of a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Head of the Institutional of both colleges will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared

1. Parties to the Agreement and the Legal Framework:

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into on this 10th day of August 2022 towards the establishment of an Agreement by and between:

DUMKAL COLLEGE, a Government Aided College Undergraduate Degree College located at Basantapur, Dist.: MURSHIDABAD, PIN - 742406, State: WEST BENGAL, INDIA established in 1999, affiliated to the University of Kalyani, Recognized by the UGC under Section 2(f) & 12(B) and represented by its Principal and referred to as FIRST PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the contest be deemed to mean and include its successor in office representatives, administrators and assigns) for the exchange of faculties for purely academic purpose.

AND

JALANGI MAHAVIDYALAYA, a Government Aided College located at Vill.- Jalangi, P.O.-Jalangi, Dist.-Murshidabad, PIN-742305, State: WEST BENGAL, INDIA established in 2010, affiliated to the University of Kalyani, represented by its Teacher -In -Charge and referred to as SECOND PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the contest be deemed to mean and include its successor in office representatives, administrators and assigns) for the exchange of faculties and infrastructural facilities for purely academic purpose.

Note: Both these institutes will be hereafter referred to as Parties.

2. Vision of the Agreement:

This agreement is drawn with a view to espouse the principles, policies, visions and objectives of the National Education Policy 2020. The Policy suggests a "seamless integration and coordination across institutions and across all stages of education". Both the institutions have the philanthropic visions to be fulfilled with regard to the MoU, which are:

- Whereas the two colleges agree upon to carry forward the ethical values and to inculcate the value of education, so that the learners can face the challenging future confidently and successfully;
- Whereas the two colleges agree upon to evolve the institute as the centres of academic excellence;
- Whereas the two colleges agree upon to construct a platform for the exploration of the potentialities of the learners to be acquainted with the global knowledge society;

Whereas the two colleges agree upon for striving to engage the students in meaningful extension activities and community welfare works.

3. Preamble:

3.1. Understanding of Cooperation:

Whereas DUMKAL COLLEGE and JALANGI MAHAVIDYALAYA agree that cooperation in research collaborations, faculty exchange and collaborations with regard to infrastructural facilities would be mutually beneficial. The areas of cooperation may include, subject to mutual consent, any desirable and feasible activity that would further the goals of each institution with regard to academic collaboration.

Therefore, pursued by the goal of common interest DUMKAL COLLEGE and JALANGI MAHAVIDYALAYA have intended to decide into the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), of which components for the cooperation are well-defined in the following Sections:

- Participation in seminars, workshops, symposia and other kinds of academic vii) discourses.
- Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work wherever feasible.
- A specific plan will be worked out for each activity and detailed arrangements for such collaborative work will be agreed upon

B. Other areas





JATINDRA RAJENDRA MAHAVIDYALAYA, a Government Aided College located at Vill.-Amtala, P.O.-Amtala, Dist.-Murshidabad, PIN-742121, State: WEST BENGAL, INDIA established in 1986, affiliated to the University of Kalyani, Recognized by the UGC under Section 2(f) &12(B) and represented by its Principal and referred to as SECOND PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the contest be deemed to mean and include its successor in office representatives, administrators and assigns) for the exchange of faculties and infrastructural facilities for purely academic purpose.

Note: Both these institutes will be hereafter referred to as Parties.

2. Vision of the Agreement:

This agreement is drawn with a view to espouse the principles, policies, visions and objectives of the National Education Policy 2020. The Policy suggests a "seamless integration and coordination across institutions and across all stages of education". Both the institutions have the philanthropic visions to be fulfilled with regard to the MoU, which are:

- Whereas the two colleges agree upon to carry forward the ethical values and to inculcate the value of education, so that the learners can face the challenging future confidently and successfully;
- Whereas the two colleges agree upon to evolve the institute as the centres of academic excellence;

- Whereas the two colleges agree upon to construct a platform for the exploration of the

3. Preamble:

3.1. Understanding of Cooperation:

Whereas DUMKAL COLLEGE and JATINDRA RAJENDRA MAHAVIDYALAYA agree that cooperation in research collaborations, faculty exchange and collaborations with regard to infrastructural facilities would be mutually beneficial. Once such Sub-agreements are approved by the both parties that will be attached as annexes to this agreement. 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





Ownership of any intellectual property (including but not limited to confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MoU shall be vested in both the colleges in this MoU. Both the colleges shall have right to determine the commercial implications, disposition and exploitation of such intellectual property and shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall be possible with prior written consent of both colleges.

ARTICLE 5: VALIDITY

Initially, the MoU shall remain in force for a period of Five years commencing from the effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

ARTICLE 6: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the Mou by giving written notice of One month in advance to institution.



ARTICLE 7: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the two colleges. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

ARTICLE 8: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case of a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Principals of both colleges will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.

Ranaghat College and Dumkal College welcome the establishment of this Memorandum for cooperation and jointly agree to the provisions set out above.
