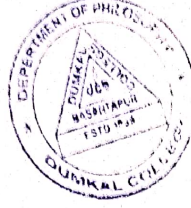



COURSE CODE	TOPICS
PHIL-Mj-T-03	a) Explain the concept of Brahman in Advaita Vedānta with reference to the formula Sat-cit-ānanda. Or, b) Explain Immanuel Kant's 'Copernican Revolution' in epistemology.
PHIL-SEC-T-03	a) Discuss the philosophy of Nişkāma Karma as presented in the <i>Śrīmadbhagavad Gītā</i> . Or, b) Nature and scope of Counselling.
PHIL-Mi-T-03	a) Classify and briefly explain the Seven Padārthas according to the Vaiśeṣika school of Indian philosophy. Or, b) Examine the unique status of Īśvara in Patañjali's Yoga Philosophy.

1. The Assignments can be written in Bengali or in English.
2. Full marks for each topic will be of 10 marks each.
3. Student will have to submit completed assignment in a single channel file and write down the answer to the topics in A4 Size paper.
