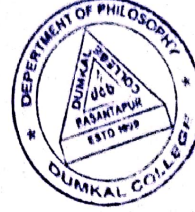

COURSE CODE	TOPICS
PHIL-MAJ-T-06	a) Critically evaluate the three primary Laws of Association as proposed by Aristotle and later refined by the British Associationists. Or, b) Critically analyze Freud's assertion that the dream is the fulfillment of a wish.
PHIL-MAJ-T-07	a) Theories about the Relation Between Individual and Society: Idealistic Theory. Or, b) Critically evaluate the socio-political efficacy of Satyāgraha as a tool for challenging colonial or oppressive power structures.
PHIL-MIN-T-03	a) Critically examine George Berkeley's famous dictum 'Esse est percipi' (To be is to be perceived). Or, b) Critically evaluate Cartesian Interactionism as a response to the mind-body problem.
