## **Dumkal College NSS Unit**

Since 2001 the College NSS Cell is organising from time to time varied types of outreach programmes, viz., programmes relating to legal awareness for poor people, awareness about poverty alleviation programmes / schemes, literacy (including women literacy), coaching for needy children, special coaching programmes for the needy students, gender rights, consumer rights, prevention of environmental pollution, eco-conservation, planting of saplings and preservation, arsenic-free water, surface water management, child health care, family planning, blood donation, anti-drug and anti-alcohol awareness, health and hygiene consciousness, campus cleaning and beautification, drainage maintenance, rural road maintenance, etc. In these programmes, conducted by some faculty members, officers and non-teaching employees, and a good number of students have participated. Most of these programmes are organized by the NSS units.

Our college has one NSS unit and the volunteers of the NSS unit are performing their activity in every branch of social work like health check-up, tree plantation, AIDS prevention, campus cleaning, slum/village cleaning along with survey of the underdeveloped people, campaign against early marriage, rural development, developing the sports facilities and physical conditions of the slums and underprivileged persons, etc. Principal of our College is always helping to increase the standard of the NSS unit.
