Description of the program:

- 2. It was an effort to motivate students to come forward and donate for this noble cause of helping others to breathe life with their precious donation.

- 3. First time donors need to be encouraged so that once the initial hesitation/ fear goes away, the donor will look forward to such camps in near future too.
- 4. To motivate all students to take a pledge to donate blood at least once in a year
- 5. To make the students aware of the scientific information about the blood group
- 6. To contribute, to some extent, to meet the excessive demand of blood as the surrounding community belongs to a very rural area and the local hospital does not have sufficient supply of blood bags.

Targeted community: As the surrounding community belongs to a very rural area and the local hospital does not have sufficient supply of blood bags, the blood collected in this camp would contribute to meet the demand to some extent. The students also can be benefitted from the same.


